Dearest Tale

It was so kind of you to call me about the the tragic death of our beloved Tomi. I had been called soon after they found her and have done all I could to try to help find her killer. Ambassador Abramovitz sent a consular officer immediately to help the police. David Barchard just called me from London and said there had been other incidents on the South coast and people were blaming the Kurds because they are so poor and desperate. I said not to spread rumors like that as David Cregan, the English sculptor who lives near Side felt that it must have been someone she recognized or she would not have been killed. I can't imagine Side without Tomi. She was such a giving, kindly, loving friend.

Earlier Monday I had heard of Kenan's death and that too was a terrible blow as we had been friends for many years. I hope that whoever takes over as Episcopos will be able to carry on his tradition of protecting Cypriodisias from the destruction that has ruined Side. Many people have told me that the one good thing happening in Side is our work on the Apollo Temple.

Now on the subject of the Temple. I send you 10 copies of the letter to Prof Atasoy. Will you please forward one to her with the list of the others that copies will go to. Then forward a copy to each of the ones I've numbered on your copy. All the names of ministers are correct. I just don't have addresses. The head of the Turkish American

Association here suggested sending me to Ambassador Topuri in President Özal's office. Orhan Eralp in the Press Department of the Foreign Affairs office is a friend of my son Alfred Jr. I'm going to a lecture by Ambassador Kuvshinov in an hour and have sent him the letter with a note from me to explain it and copies of the last two News letters so he'll have some back ground.

Also today I've written another brief news letter and will illustrate it with the picture Zeynep gave me of the big corner piece being put in place. I hope it will raise a little money toward next year's work.

I hope you have a happy fall and winter and we'll celebrate together next spring.
