I'm not sure where you are right now as I did not write down your schedule when you last called. I'm still not very well organized since getting home as I get depressed from time to time, but I am better each day and the doctors say eventually my hand will be well. The shock of the crash really affected me all over and I'm still getting bits of glass out of my right arm and shoulder.

Well on to happier thoughts. I expect my whole family for Thanksgiving next week. We'll be 26 at the first we Table so you see how really lucky I am.

I enclose another check which I hope will pay for the repairs to the crane and any other work you need done this winter. This has been an expensive year for me supporting the International Friends of Side as I haven't had any outside support since I didn't do a News letter. I hope to get one out soon. Some of the photos taken by Jim Rose are very good and Buntor had done a sketch of the crane putting up the last column. How do things stand now? How many capitals are in place? When will the work stop for this year? Do write me a short resumé of this year's work.
