My dear Mr Washburn,

We are all very much concerned about our Aunt's health, and we are inclined to think that she ought to give up her post, at all events she should at once retire from all activity for a few days and see if she cannot pick up her strength again, & get into a natural state of health.

Mrs Calhoun will not listen to us, I therefore beg of you to use your influence with her in respect upon her

having a duty she owes to
herself, her relations as well
as to the College.
