Meanwhile, I am actively pursuing Babylon bronzes for you - a Private "O" Collector in NYC has now shown me the enclosed, The last of the "Alexander with the Lance" types, a similar arm (the raised right arm holding the spear or sceptre-staff), two splendid fragments of drapery from a lifesized (or slightly over) female (with a platform sandal), and a complete (overlifesized) female (head and neck missing) who has the drapery, replete with fringed himation or shawl, of the Babia from Magnesia on the Maeander.
