I just write to thank you for the most interesting offprint concerning the Sebastian at Bulon.

I do not know if you have seen the catalog *Glories of the Past: Sculpture from the Shelby White and Leon Levy Collection* (New York, 1990). Item no. 172 (pages 237-38) is the Weary Herakles in Boston; no. 174 (pages 240-241) is the Lucius Voren (your pl. XXVII). Their no. 275 173 (pages 238-40), is an over-life-size nude male statue, 221 cms high, which to my eye looks somewhat like your pl. XXIX (Commodus) though it now has a head. From your measurement (p. 224) the torso is 1,40 m x the right leg 0,86 m, which is close but not


identified. I leave this for others better qualified to judge.
